## Vocabulary Usage of Pre-School Children The Statistical Dominance of Core Vocabulary

In the present study of preschool children, the $\mathbf{5 0}$ most frequently occurring words represent approximately $60 \%$ of the total sample, while the 100 most frequently occurring words accounted for $73 \%$ of the total sample. (The Jones Sampling, Lincoln Nebraska, 1987)
(The top 250 words accounted for $85 \%$ of the total words.)

... the 50 most frequently occurring words of a sample account for 40 to $50 \%$ of the total words communicated, while the 100 most frequently occurring words accounted for $60 \%$ of the total sample.

## The Balandin Sampling, AAC, 1999

- Conversational samples were collected from 34 non-disabled subjects across four work sites
- There was a small stable core vocabulary of 347 words which accounted for $78 \%$ of the conversational sample

- Places: participants' home, restaurants, apartment complexes, community rooms, stores, malls, hospitals, churches, cars, friends, and relatives' homes, senior citizen centers, and outdoors.
- Activities: talking on the telephone, eating, household projects, shopping, church study, playing games, reviewing hobbies, volunteer work, watching movies, transportation to events, and "visiting."


## Vocabulary Usage by Adult Augmented Communicators

- 40 hours of interviews with 20 augmented communicators
- The 100 most frequently occurring words account for $62.3 \%$ of the total words used
- The top 250 words comprised 78\% of the total words
