


I was running a sibling session at Variety Motor Mouth Camp, teaching families how AAC brings people together.



I use my device to tell everyone all about what I am doing, and I love saying silly words on there with my family.





Hi, I'm Harper.


I'm 9 years old. I love cooking and eating delicious food, spending time with family and reading.

“ Hi, I’m Natalie.



Hi, I'm Jess.

I use my communication device to do lots of things – including training my dog, Milly, my Golden Retriever.

I pre-programmed some basic commands for Milly on my device: “Milly Come”, “Milly Stay”, “Milly Sit” and “Good girl”. It took about a year of training for Milly to recognise the commands from my communication device.

I tried a few different voices on my AAC device, but Milly only responds to the ‘Ivona – Nicole’ voice command – she has her preferences! I love taking Milly to parks and to the beach, and she listens to me using my AAC device.

Everybody told me I couldn't have a dog because I wouldn't be able to train her. With constant everyday training and the help of my communication device, I proved them wrong!

I'm so glad I didn't listen to them – Milly is a large part of my life, my family, and is my baby!”
